## GENERAL ORDER CONCERNING DIVISION OF CASES BETWEEN JUDGES

Cases will be assigned by the Clerk as follows:

Chapter 13: All cases will be assigned to Judge Jackson.

Chapter 7: Cases will be assigned randomly in such numbers so that Judge Weaver and Judge Hall each receive Forty-five percent (45%) of the cases filed and Judge Jackson receives Ten percent (10%) of the cases filed.

Chapters 9, 11, 12, and 15: Cases will be assigned randomly so that all judges are assigned substantially the same **equila** number of cases under each chapter.

Adversary: Adversary proceedings will be assigned pursuant to the assignment of the bankruptcy case.

This order shall be effective on September 1, 2010 and supersedes any previous order regarding the assignment of cases.
