On January 7, 2020, this court entered General Order 20-1 adopting Interim Bankruptcy Rules implementing the Small Business Reorganization Act of 2019. On December 1, 2022, amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure became effective. These amendments address rules and procedures regarding the Small Business Reorganization Act of 2019, replacing the Interim Bankruptcy Rules. As a result, General Order 20-1 is now abrogated.¹

¹ General Order 22-03, "In re: Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1020," entered on July 20, 2022, remains in effect. General Order 22-03 adopts Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1020 to modify the definition of "debtor" for determining eligibility to proceed under subchapter V of chapter 11 and to increase the debt threshold in subchapter V cases while the Bankruptcy Threshold Adjustment and Technical Corrections Act remains in effect.
