ORDER

The Court hereby amends G.O. 20-11 to delete the prohibition of more than 10 people in a courtroom gallery at any time. The United States Marshals Service, however, is directed to ensure that all persons in a courtroom gallery are sufficiently spaced to provide for adequate social distancing. Based on spacing requirements, when a courtroom reaches its capacity, additional persons will be excluded from the courtroom and, when available, redirected to an overflow courtroom where they can monitor the particular proceedings via remote audio or audio-visual presentation.

All other provisions of G.O. 20-11 shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
