**ORDER ADOPTING OFFICIAL FORMS AND
REVISING LOCAL RULES AND POLICIES**

Pursuant to order of the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts, forms for the Bankruptcy Courts will be revised effective December 1, 2015. The Court hereby adopts those official forms.

To conform local rules and policies to the form changes, the Court orders as follows:

The Debtor's Statement of Social Security Number, Form 121, shall be filed as a private entry in all individual cases.


References in the Local Rules to Summaries of Schedules and Statistical Summaries shall now refer to Official Form 106Sum, Summary of Your Assets and Liabilities and Certain Statistical Information, for individuals and to Official Form 206Sum, Summary of Assets and Liabilities for Non-Individuals, for non-individuals.

The Clerk of the Court for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Oklahoma shall require that individual Chapter 7, Chapter 13, and Chapter 11 debtors file the Financial Management Course Certificate in addition to completing Official Form 423. Official Form 423 contains a typographical error and the Certificate is required if an individual debtor files under Chapter 11. A discharge cannot be entered until the Financial Management Course Completion Certificate is filed and the case may be administratively closed if the Certificate is not filed timely.


A non-individual filing schedules shall not be required to file Schedules C, I, and J as is required by Local Rule 1007-1 A. However, other forms may be required.

This order shall become effective on December 1, 2015.
